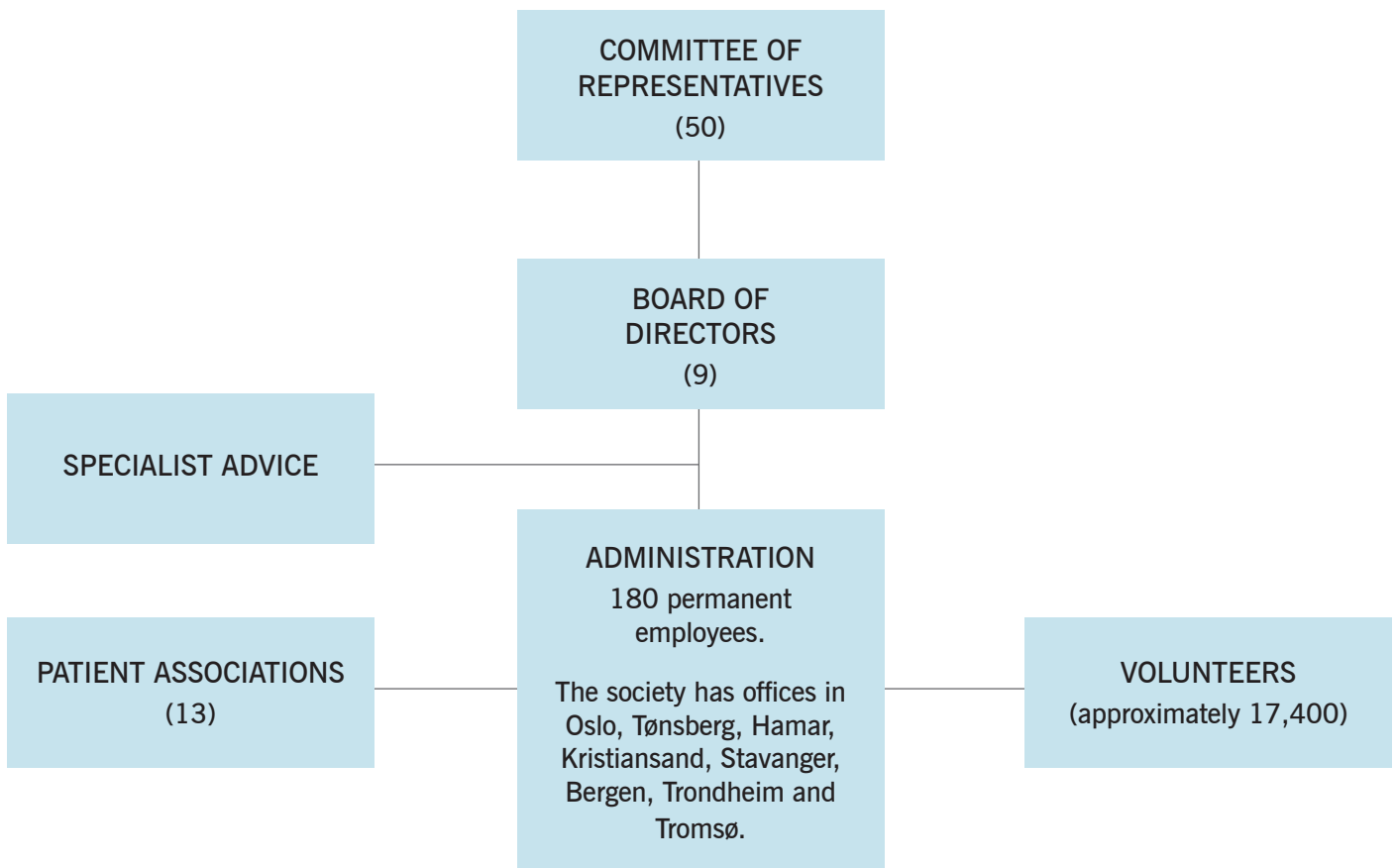




NORWEGIAN CANCER SOCIETY

PATIENT ASSOCIATIONS

Patient associations are separate legal entities, but as such they are members of the Norwegian Cancer Society. The twelve patient associations have approx. 31,000 members who represent cancer patients and their families, and they consist of:

NORWEGIAN CANCER SOCIETY COMMITTEE OF REPRESENTATIVES

The highest body is the Committee of Representatives, with 50 members. The Committee is composed of different groups:

- Personal members: 17
- Corporate members (Norwegian Nurses' Organisation, Norwegian Medical Association, Norwegian Union of Municipal and General Employees): 3
- Institutional members (Faculty of Medicine, Cancer Registry of Norway etc.): 15
- Patients' associations (associate members): 12
- Employee representatives: 3

Members of the Committee of Representatives are selected from the member group, patient associations, institutional members (research institutions etc.) and from the corporate members and employee representatives.

NORWEGIAN CANCER SOCIETY BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board is a collegial and professional body with members who represent expertise in the areas of medicine/health care, research, business/marketing, law, politics, communication, management and corporate governance, organization, and economics as well as user representatives/persons who have or have had cancer and who possess knowledge of patient experience.

VOLUNTEERS

The Norwegian Cancer Society has approximately 370 volunteers in the field of cancer care, and approximately 17,000 in income-generating operations.
